Welcome to the Spread Eagle Hotel, a characterful family hotel in the centre of the Royal Burgh of Jedburgh. The hotel is within easy walking distance of the whole town and combines over 500 years of history with all the modern comforts you would expect.

Only an hour from the Edinburgh city bypass, (or indeed from Newcastle) you can take advantage of the variety of active pursuits available in the Scottish Borders, or simply unwind in the private lounge and bar.

John and Lorna, along with two-year-old Frances, are your resident hosts.

Local historians believe that a building on the site of the hotel was constructed some time around 1450 and was part of the abbey holdings in Jedburgh. The hotel was licensed in 1604, the year in which licenses were first issued by the Government in an attempt to control the price of beer. Famous guests since then have included Lord Darnley (later married to Mary Queen of Scots), Sir Walter Scott, the Rolling Stones and Acker Bilk.
